





Ten Commandments

- 1. Kether (Crown): Thou shalt have no other God's before me
 - Devotion or Love: Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, soul, mind and strength
- 2. Hokkmah (Wisdom, Likeness): Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image...you shall not bow down yourself to them, nor serve them
 - Worship the real God, not the Deities created by men, including priests and the traditions of the fathers
- 3. Binah (Understanding, Difference): Thou shalt not take [use] the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him guiltless...
 - Separate the sacred from the profane
 - · Don't commit evil in God's name




Ten Commandments

- 4. Da'ath (Knowledge, Orientation): Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy
 - The principle of Jubilee, the release from bondage
- 5. Hesed (Mercy, Compassion): Honor your father and mother, that your days may be long upon the land...
 - Care for your parents, the aged, the widow, the orphan, the poor, the weak or helpless
- 6. Din (Judgment, Power): You shall not kill.
 - Don't murder, don't assault people
 - Don't be angry with your brother or call him a fool




Ten Commandments

- 7. Tif'ereth (Beauty, Harmony): You shall not commit adultery
 - · Don't betray people in relationships
 - · Keep in right relationship with other people
- 8. Netsah (Endurance, Victory): You shall not steal
 - · Don't get gain by unjust means
 - Respect other people's property and possessions
- 9. Hod (Substance, Wealth): You will not bear false witness against your neighbor
 - · Don't defame another person's character
 - Don't try to use the government or legal system to harm other people




Ten Commandments

- 10. Yesod (Foundation): You shall not covet...anything that is your neighbors
 - · Don't seek that which is not your own
 - · Be grateful for what you have




Ages (Dispensations)

- 1. Kether (Crown): Adam to Enoch
- 2. Hokhmah (Wisdom): Enoch to Noah
- 3. Binah (Understanding): Noah to Abraham to Moses
- 4. Da'ath (Knowledge): Moses to Jesus
- 5. Hesed (Mercy): Jesus through the middle ages
- 6. Din (Judgment): Middle ages until recently
- 7. Tif'erteth (Beauty, Harmony): Now through the millenium
- 8. Netsah (Victory, Endurance):Satan is loosed for season for a final battle
- 9. Hod (Glory, Wealth): Final Judgement
- 10. Yesod (Foundation): A New Heaven and Earth, "It is finished."




Twelve Tribes

- 2. Hokhmah (Wisdom): Reuben (see a son) Firstborn of Leah, unstable did not excel
- 3. Binah (Understanding): Simeon (one who hears) Second born of Leah, aggressive, violent, divided and scattered in Israel along with Levi
- Da'ath (Knowledge): Levi (to be attached) became the Levitical priests
- 5. Hesed (Mercy): Judah (praise) lineage of Kings and of the house of David and ultimately Christ




Twelve Tribes

- 6. Din (Judgment): Dan (he has vindicated, judged) First son of Bilhah, handmaid of Rachel, "Dan shall judge his people..."
- 7. Tif'erteth (Beauty, Harmony): Naphtali (my struggle) Second son of Bilhah, Like a female doe that runs free and bears beautiful fawns (or words)
- Netsah (Victory, Endurance): Gad (troop or fortune)
 First son of Zilpah, Leah's handmaid "a troop shall overcome him, but he shall overcome at last"
- Hod (Glory, Wealth): Asher (Blessed, happy) —
 Zilpah's second, "Asher's bread will be fat and he will yield royal dainties"




Twelve Tribes

- 10. Yesod (Foundation): Issachar (reward) —
 Another son from Leah, a strong donkey that will be forced into slavery
- 11. Malkhuth (Kingdom): Zebulun (honor or exalted abode), Leah's 6th son, "Zebulun will dwell at the haven of the sea, and he shall be a haven of ships"
- O. Ein Sof (Endless) Joseph (he will add), Rachel's first, "a fruitful bow by a well, whose branches run over the wall" head of the "lost tribes"
- 1. Kether (Crown) Benjamin (son of my sorrow), Rachel's second, dying in childbirth, a ravenous wolf who divides the spoils



Spiritual Gifts

- 1. Kether (Crown): Faith in Jesus Christ
- 2. Hokhmah (Wisdom): Ability to teach words of wisdom
- 3. Binah (Understanding): Ability to teach words of knowledge
- 4. Da'ath (Knowledge): Ability to exercise great faith
- 5. Hesed (Mercy): Ability to heal others (or have faith to be healed)



Spiritual Gifts

- 6. Din (Judgment, Power): The ability to work miracles
- 7. Tif'erteth (Beauty, Harmony): The ability to prophesy of all things
- 8. Netsah (Victory, Endurance): Discerning or beholding angels and ministering spirits
- 9. Hod (Glory, Wealth): Ability to speak in tongues
- 10. Yesod (Foundation): Ability to interpret tongues and languages
